
KEY FINDINGS FROM THE STRATEGIC PLANNING SURVEY 2018

What's Next For THE INTERNATIONAL ACCOUNTABILITY PROJECT

The International Accountability Project's strategic planning process will guide and inform our ongoing work to reinforce community-led development through 2024. As part of this process, IAP engaged partners, board members, donors and supporters through feedback sessions and a survey to seek their input on IAP's programmatic activities and priorities. We invited more than 100 partners to provide feedback on IAP's priorities in a survey, with a majority of respondents comprising civil society organizations, community partners and peoples'movements. The key findings from the survey are summarized here:

What best describes you? I am part of:






In the next 5 years, what should IAP focus on?
